
## **Cove Ceiling**

Included in your cove ceiling kit:

- a. Cove Pieces
- b. Inside Corners
- c. Outside Corners

Tools needed:

- a. Nail Gun
- d. Tape Measure
- b. Brad Nailer / Stapler
- c. Circular Saw
- e. Square
- f. Snap Line






## Choose one of the four different sytles.


No Reveal- At each corner of the room measure and mark the wall down from the ceiling <u>14</u> inches (rise). Measure and mark the ceiling out from the wall <u>14</u> inches (rise).




Top Reveal- At each corner of the room measure and mark the wall down from the ceiling <u>14</u> inches plus the thickness of your reveal (rise). Measure and mark the ceiling out from the wall <u>14</u> inches (rise).



Bottom Reveal- At each corner of the room measure and mark the wall down from the ceiling \_\_\_\_14 \_\_\_ inches (rise). Measure and mark the ceiling out from the wall \_\_\_14 \_\_\_ inches plus the thickness of your reveal (rise).




Top & Bottom Reveal- At each corner of the room measure and mark the wall down from the ceiling \_\_\_\_14 \_\_\_ inches plus the thickness of your reveal (rise). Measure and mark the ceiling out from the wall \_\_\_\_14 \_\_\_ inches plus the thickness of your reveal (rise).

Snap a line at the marks on the wall and along the ceiling around the entire perimeter of the room.






If using a reveal, line up the sides of the ledgers to your snap line and nail in place. Note: Blocking between the wall studs and/or in the ceiling may be necessary to sufficiently attach the cove pieces.






Using a brad nailer / stapler, install your inside (90°) and/or outside (90°) corners to align with your snap line.






Install any other corners which are not 90° (a right angle) by angle cutting the bottom of a cove piece and aligning it to your snap line. Brad nail / staple in place.






Brad nail / staple all cove pieces 16" O.C. along the walls and ceilings between all the corners. Note: Wherever a reveal has not been used, blocking between the wall studs and/or in the ceiling may be necessary to sufficiently attach the cove pieces.





If necessary and/or according to code requirements, fire block the cove ceiling along the perimeter.





You are now ready for electric and drywall!
